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LEARNING INNOVATION 101

Learning Innovation 101 is an **offline program** designed for law students who want to engage more deeply with the law and its impact on the world around them. We believe that law school does not just include market understanding but also should teach **foundational legal concepts with problem solving and critical thinking**, helping students strengthen core skills like structured reasoning, argument analysis, and spotting logical fallacies. Through interactive discussions and practical activities, participants learn to approach real-life challenges with clarity and purpose.

A central part of the experience is an immersive project based on design thinking. Students observe challenges within communities, conduct fieldwork to understand user perspectives, and collaborate to develop grounded, creative responses. **This feel-do-think-share model encourages reflection, teamwork, and solution-oriented thinking.**

This is not a traditional lecture format. It is a space for law students to think independently, ask sharper questions, and apply their learning beyond the classroom. In addition to the Aspire sessions, modules can be customised to meet specific learning goals or institutional needs. The program runs over **3 to 5 days**.
